- ✝ To support the provision of pastoral care, confidential support and practical assistance to College families especially in challenging times.
- ✝ To encourage and create opportunities for friendship among College families.
- ✝ To support new families to the College so that they feel welcome and part of the College community.

How can the parent support group offer pastoral and practical help?

Where practical class leaders may help by:

Organising social activities during the year.

Welcoming new families to Trinity and assisting them to integrate into the College community.

Inviting new families to PTFA meetings.

Encouraging families to support College events.

Supporting our families in times of need by offering assistance if required.

Inform parents of the appropriate channels to use within the College and assist in passing on feedback to the College principal.

Encouraging families to help each other.

Communicating with their class teacher and class group.

- Make suggestions to your class leader for class social activities and offer to help organize them.
- Attend and encourage others to become involved in social activities and school events.
- Assist by making a meal for a family in a time of need.
