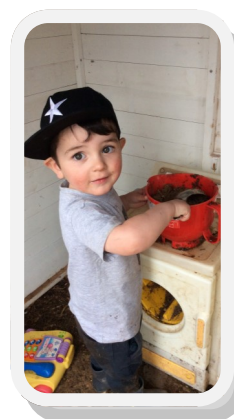
Programs for the Pelican Kids
